

FIND THE FISH MEMORY GAME

CONTENTS

Nine wooden Big Fish, nine wooden Little Fish, and rules.


OBJECT

Be first to collect a school of fish (one yellow, one blue and one green) and win!

SET UP

All the players close their eyes as an adult stands up the nine Little Fish in a 3×3 pattern and then covers them with the Big Fish as shown.







STEP 2























PLAY

- 1) The youngest player goes first. If that's you, choose a Big Fish and carefully lift it up to reveal a Little Fish under it. Be careful to lift straight up, or you may knock over the Little Fish hiding under it.
- Next, with your other hand, try and find a colored Little Fish that matches the one you just found by lifting another Big Fish up.
- If the two Little Fish you uncover do not match, place the two Big Fish back down over the two Little Fish and end your turn.
 - If you uncover a matching pair of Little Fish, take JUST ONE of the Little Fish and place it in front of you. Place one Big Fish back down over the other Little Fish you uncovered and place the second Big Fish back down on the empty space where it was. This ends your turn.
 - 5) If you lift up a Big Fish to find no Little Fish under it, place the Big Fish back where it was and end your turn.
- You may not have two Little Fish of the same color. If you lift up a Big Fish to find a Little Fish matching the color of one you already

have collected, place the Big Fish back where it was and end your turn.

In the event of a draw, understand that Little Fish are hard to catch. Set the game up and play again!

Remember the goal of the game is to be the first player to get one yellow Little Fish, one blue Little Fish and one green Little Fish to make your school and win the game! Pay attention when it is not your turn and try and remember where the different colored Little Fish are hiding and later in the game, where none are hiding!
